Sub: Duties of the livestock Development Assistants working in the Department of Animal Husbandry, Haryana.

After detailed deliberations on the subject above and in consultation with the "Specialists" from Haryana Agriculture University Hisar, the associations of the Veterinary Surgeons and the VLDA and on the advice of the Director, Animal Husbandry, Haryana, the Govt. have decided that the V.L.D.As, will continue to perform the duties (in their respective areas) being so done by them at present and as already assigned to them by the Director, Animal Husbandry (under the caption "Duties of Veterinary & Livestock Development Assistants working in the Animal Husbandry Hr.) All the Dy. Directors, S.D.Os(AH) and all the Drawing and Disbursing Officers in the State and others concerned may be informed accordingly. To avoid any ambiguity and by way of reiteration, the chart of duties is annexed ~~at~~ herewith.

Duties of Veterinary & Livestock Development Assistant working in  
Animal Husbandry Department Haryana.

1. To perform Artificial Insemination in cows and buffaloes.
2. To follow up the Artificial Insemination cases and maintain record.
3. To vaccinate animals against diseases to control diseases and to take timely veterinary aid measures.
4. To register cattle for milk yield.
5. To guide villagers regarding feed and fodder and cattle to increase their milk yield, procurement of seeds for demonstration plots.
6. Treatment of simple and minor ailments.
7. To maintain official records of key village units, stockman centres, veterinary dispensary, sheep and wool Extension Centres, Poultry Extension Centres, Piggery Extension Centres.
8. To keep the equipments of the institutions clean.
9. Compounding and dispensing of medicines.
10. Rendering assistance to the Vety. Surgeons/Animal Husbandry Assistants Incharge of Vety. Hospital/Dispensary while performing major operations.
11. To help Vety. Surgeons/Animal Husbandry Officers in maintaining the record of the institutions.
12. To attend to the MFAL/SFDA/programmes.
