**Subject: - Scheme for Providing Employment Opportunities to Scheduled Castes and Insurance of their Livestock (2013-14).**

Memo

- Animal Wealth Scheme for providing employment opportunities to the Scheduled castes and insurance of their livestock is a continued programme of the department which is proposed to be implemented in the State during the 12'h Five Year Plan also. The scheme in principle stands approved by the Govt. and the detail of the scheme & basic data of livestock is as under:-

**BASIC DATA OF LIVESTOCK AMONG SCs:**

According to the livestock census 2007, about 22.27 lac families are rearing one or other type of livestock in the state out of which 8.86 lacs are Scheduled caste families who are gener~ly resource poor. Occupation wise, out of a total 8.86 Scheduled d Caste families, 44% exclusively depends on Animal Husbandry & Agriculture and 56% on other sectors including service sector. Out of total livestock population in the state, Scheduled caste families possess 23% of the livestock though of low genetic merit. Scheduled Caste families contribute substantively in the Animal Husbandry sector and it is the major occupation of these families.

The trend o( rearing of livestock species by SC's in Haryana is given the following table:-

The above table shows that out of the total livestock population in the state, Sheep, Goat and Pig upto 60-80% are reared by Scheduled caste families whereas milch Animals only upto 16% only.

Under the Special Component Plan schemes, which would provide direct benefit to the Scheduled castes following components have been induced:-

(i) **Employment opportunities (Rs. 2.40 crore)**

The ongoing component scheme has been included in the Annual Plan for the year 2013-14 with the sole objective of providing employment opportunities to the Scheduled Castes in the State. There is a target to set up 1200 units as per detailed given below:-

Financial assistance to the tune of 25% of the unit cost will be provided by the Govt. in the shape of subsidy whereas the remaining part will be the contribution of the beneficiaries either as loan from the financial institutions or self. The self contribution towards this activity may include already available livestock, cart, shed, land, feeding, management, labour and any other related assets with the Scheduled Caste families the cost of which will be counted as the share of the beneficiary Scheduled Caste family.

**Note:** Subsidy would be provided after establishment of the unit.

(ii) **Supply of feed Supplement (Rs. 2.00 crore)**

A provision has also been made for the payment of 40% charges of the feed supplement to be given to the female cross bred and Murrah buffalo calves as per ongoing programme under RKVY.

(iii) **Strengthening of the Piggery Farms (Rs. 0.60 crore)**

Provision has also been made in this scheme for the strengthening of the existing Piggery Farms Ambala and Hisar to ensure supply of piglets to the beneficiaries by multiplying the number of animals and to setup new bars to meet the constant increasing demand of the Pig farmers as well as keeping in view the requirement of beneficiaries for setting up the Piggery Units under the SCSP.

(iv) **Livestock Insurance (Rs. 6.00 crore)**

In the State, 8.86 lac Scheduled Caste families are rearing one or the other type of livestock and any family owning as many as number of animals will be

insured under the scheme. This special livestock insurance scheme for Scheduled Caste families will be available throughout the State and the rates of insurance premium will be finalized by the department after negotiation with the insurance company. Animals as per detail given below will be insured under the scheme. The entire cost of insurance and publicity on the pattern of GOI i.e. Honorarium to Vety. Surgeon for production of Health Certificate & Post Mortem on the pattern of GOI, entire cost of insurance premium including agents commission and publicity will be borne by the State Govt. under the scheme.

The special livestock insurance scheme for Scheduled caste families will be available through out the State and the rates of insurance premium and other terms & } Insurance for 1 to 3 years will be finalized by inviting open tenders. However keeping in view the volume of work and budgetary provision all the units of 2 milch animals, piggery and sheep units setup under this scheme will be covered for free insurance coverage under the scheme. Besides, this following species/ categories would also be covered under the scheme for free insurance coverage.

**Publicity of the scheme**

A wide publicity of the scheme is to be made for which a minimum sum of Rs. 5000 per block annually amounting to Rs. 5.50 lac for the year 2013-14, is proposed and this amount will be borne by the State Govt. under the scheme.

For meeting out the expenses on all these components of the scheme, a provision of Rs. 1100 lac has been made for the year 2013-14.

The expenditure involved shall be debited to the budget grant under head:-

- 2403-A Animal Husbandry (Plan)**
- 789-Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes**
- Scheme for Employment opportunities to Scheduled castes and insurance of their Livestock for the year 2013-14.**

The Director General, Animal Husbandry & Dairying Haryana, Panchkula will be the officer in charge of all controlling and Drawing & Disbursing Officer for the scheme. Besides this, the Chief Superintendent, Govt. Livestock Farm, Hisar, Deputy Director, Intensive Cattle Development Project, Ambala, Kamal, Kurukshetra, Bhiwani, Sirsa, Jind, Gurgaon and Deputy Director, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Fatehabad, Faridabad, Hisar, Jhajjar, Kaithal, Narnaul, Panchkula, Panipat, Rewari, Yamunanagar, Rohtak, Sonapat, Mewat at Nuh, Palwal and the Piggery Development Officer, Ambala will be the Drawing & Disbursing Officers of the scheme. The Govt. is requested that the administrative cum financial sanction of the scheme for the year 2013-14 may kindly be accorded, please.

VI The Governor of Haryana is pleased to accord administrative approval-cum-financial sanction to the continuance of the scheme cited as subject during the year 2013-14 on non-recurring basis at a total estimated cost of ₹ 2.75/- (Two Crore Seventy Five Lacs only) for first installment as per enclosed statement of cost subject to the following conditions:-

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- i) Scheme is approved in the budget Estimate of the department.
  - ii) No new post will be created under the scheme and no vacant post would be filled up without prior approval of Finance Department.
  - iii) The expenditure of the year will be passed out in four quarters viz 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 25%, 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 20%, 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 25% and 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 30%.
  - IV) Instruction on economy measures issued by the Finance Department from time to time will be strictly adhered to.
  - v) Quarterly physical targets (District wise) for regular monitoring for all the three schemes (Milch Animal, Piggery and Sheeps raising) will also be indicated.
