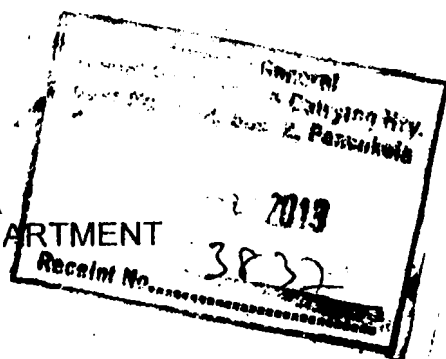

ORDER



Vide FIR No. 1 of 6:1.2011, a criminal case under Section 7(a) of the

Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 was lodged by State Vigilance Bureau, Ambala against Dr. Devinder Sindhvani, S/o Sh. Yash Pal, Veterinary Surgeon, Government Veterinary Hospital, Hari Garh Borakh, Distt. Kurukshetra alleging therein that Dr. Devinder Sindhvani, Veterinary Surgeon has demanded and accepted Rs. 2000/- from one Sukhwinder Singh for conducting the post-mortem on dead body of two cattle's. On completion of trial, Sh. Devinder Sindhvani, Veterinary Surgeon was held guilty for the commission of offence punishable under Section 7 & 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act by Additional Session Judge, Kurukshetra vide judgment dated 16.10.2012 and the following punishment has been awarded:-

3. The menace of corruption is assuming alarming proportion these days. Even common man is up in arms against the wide spread cancer of corruption, yearning for corruption free society. This menace has to be curbed with strong hands. Such like culprits do not deserve any leniency and should be given exemplary punishment. However, at the same time, this court cannot ignore the aspect that the convict before the court has to look after his family members and he is not a previous convict. In the opinion of this court, the ends of justice would be suitably met if the convict is sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a term of two years and to pay a fine of Rs. 5000/- under section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. In default of payment of fine the convict shall further undergo simple imprisonment for a term of one month. The convict is further sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a term of three years and to pay a fine of Rs. 5000/- under section 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. In default of payment of fine, the convict shall further undergo simple imprisonment for a term of one month.

4. Both the sentences shall run concurrently. Fine paid.

5. All the exhibits of the case along with case property be kept intact till the expiry of period of appeal/revision limitation for filing if any or as per decision thereof.

From the perusal of facts and circumstances of the case as well as the judgment dated 16.10.2012 passed by Addl. Session Judge Kurukshetra, the Government of Haryana is rightly satisfied that the conduct of Dr. Devinder Sindhvani, Veterinary Surgeon, which led to his conviction for offences under sections 7 & 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 (which also involves moral turpitude) is such as to render his further retention in public service undesirable. In pursuance of the above and under Article 311 (2) of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Haryana
